

Fire Safety Information in Ripon College Residence Halls

Anytime you hear a fire alarm sounding or see smoke/fire GET OUT of the building. Dial 911 to alert Fire/Police/EMS to our emergency.

Below are the evacuation spots where students are to report in the event that their building is emptied because of possible fire or other emergency.

Fire Evacuation Spots:

Tri Dorms	Exit South: Across Thorne Street Exit North: Memorial Lawn
Johnson	Exit South: Across Thorne Street Exit North or Northwest (Guam): Memorial Lawn
Apartments	Exit South: Across Thorne Street Exit East: Lawn in front of Bartlett Hall
Scott	Exit South or Southeast: Across Thorne Street Exit Northwest: Lawn on East end of Mapes (keep service drive clear) Exit East: base of footpath by Johnson Hall (keep service drive clear)
Anderson	The lawn on East side of Brockway Hall (keep service drive clear)
Bovay	The lawn on East side of Anderson, by the volleyball courts (keep service drive clear)
Brockway	The lawn on East side of Anderson, by the volleyball courts (keep service drive clear)
Mapes	The lawn on East side of Anderson, by the volleyball courts (keep service drive clear)

Fire Prevention in our Residence Halls

1. Be familiar with at least two ways out of your building. An evacuation chart is posted on the back of the door in every sleeping room. Familiarize yourself with the location of pull stations and fire extinguishers.
2. The following are prohibited in all Residence Halls: halogen lamps, heat lamps, candles, incense, toasters, grills, hot plates, incense, space heaters, explosives, firewood or any open flame.
3. Never leave food unattended while cooking. Cooking, and most cooking appliances are not allowed in student rooms. Microwave ovens, coffee makers, contact cooking devices (i.e. George Foreman grills) and enclosed hot pots are allowed.
4. Smoking is prohibited in all areas of the Residence Halls. Discarded smoking materials are a major cause of fires.
5. Do not block hallways or stairs with bicycles, boxes, furniture, trash or other items. In the event of an emergency the corridors and stairwells are your lifeline to the outdoors and safety.
6. Avoid overloading electrical outlets. We recommend UL listed power strips equipped with a circuit breaker.
7. Never leave hair dryers or irons on unattended. Never use hair dryers to dry clothes.
8. Flammable liquids such as lighter fluid, propane or gasoline are prohibited in Residence Halls.
9. Fire extinguishers are provided for your protection. Malicious use will result in fines.
10. We recommend that each student have a flashlight for power outages or other emergencies.
