Ripon College Democrats

Total Cost: \$250

The Ripon College Democrats are requesting \$250 from the One-fund to host a screening of *Inequality for All*, a documentary made by Robert Reich, a professor of public policy at UC Berkley, and former Secretary of Labor. The film explores the problems of widening inequality in the United States. A screening will serve to better educate the Ripon College community and student body on economic problems facing us today.

The film will be shown on February 20 at 4:00 PM and it will be open to all who wish to attend. This time coincides with the National Campus Screening event for the film. Following the film, we will show a live interactive webcast with Robert Reich, the creator of the film. The Ripon College Democrats will hold a discussion following the webcast if there is sufficient interest.

The \$250 covers the license to show the film, the DVD, and discussion materials. We will also be able to keep the DVD and make it permanently available in the Ripon College library for check-out.

Other Pricing Options

The \$250 dollar rate is a discount available to college campuses from the normal price of \$395. Streaming rights are also available for \$590 and allow the film to be uploaded to the school server.
